

WE GOT THIS!

CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE IS PREVENTABLE DO YOUR PART!

1. Report! Report! Report!
2. Follow Oregon's Mandatory Reporting laws and your policies, including reporting and background checks.
3. Teach the warning signs of adult sexual misconduct, such as abuse, grooming, and appropriate vs inappropriate behaviors towards minors.
4. It is not a minors' responsibility to prevent or protect themselves from abuse. As adults, that responsibility falls on us!
5. Minors rarely lie about abuse. Assume they are telling the truth.
6. Trust your gut! If something doesn't feel right, it probably isn't.
7. If you are a mandatory reporter, you must report suspicions of child abuse or neglect to authorities. **Call the abuse hotline (DHS) 855-503-SAFE (7233) or law enforcement.**
8. Ensure that all adults are using appropriate electronic communications with minors.
9. Be aware of secluded or isolated areas in your building where grooming behavior or abuse can happen, and work to mitigate the risk.
10. If you see something, stop it and say something
